THE SCHOOL

DAIS is an English medium, K-12 co-educational, private, non-profit day school founded in 2003. It is fully accredited by the **Council of International Schools (CIS) and New England Association of Schools and Colleges. (NEASC).** DAIS provides a learning environment that encourages children to bring out their best and which supports their all-round development, through discovering the joy of learning, awakening and illuminating their intellect in multi-dimensional ways, and instilling abiding values. The DAIS motto is 'Dare to Dream, Learn to Excel".

CHRRICHHAM

- Lower KG to Grade 7: an integrated curriculum of national and international examination boards.
- Grades 8 to 10: students choose either the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education programme (ICSE) or the University of Cambridge's International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) programme.
- Grades 11 and 12: pursue the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBD) Programme.

ADMISSION

Almost two thirds of the cohort at the IBDP comes through the school, whereas the rest join us in grade 11 through a selection process comprising of admission tests and interactions.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

DAIS operates on a semester calendar with Semester 1 from end-July to end-December and Semester 2 from early January to mid-June and the Senior class graduates at the end of May. Final High School Transcripts will be sent to attending institutions in the first week of June and Official IB Diploma results will be forwarded to attending institutions in the first week of July.

HIGH SCHOOL COURSE LOAD

- Grades 9 & 10: ICSE (8 courses of two years duration) and IGCSE: (Minimum of 8 and maximum of 11 courses) of two years duration.
- Grade 11 & 12: All students enrol in the IB Diploma Programme, completing between six and seven 2-year long courses (3/4 x HL and 3 x SL), TOK, Extended Essay and CAS.

STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES

We encourage students to delve into their passions beyond the classroom through sport, co-curricular activities and community service. These include Student Council leadership, MUN, Robotics, TEDx Youth@DAIS, Round Square, DAIS Study & Activity Centre, Annual Day production and student exchange programmes worldwide. Community service begins at grade one up till year 12, including service and support activities in villages, slums, disadvantaged schools and local NGOs. Sports played at local, national and international levels include soccer, basketball, cricket, golf, equestrian, gymnastics, skating, yachting, judo, taekwondo, karate, swimming, tennis, table-tennis, chess, squash and badminton. Our students also lead the annual IB Sports Fest for all international schools in the Mumbai region.

OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Through the pandemic, DAIS maintained education technology and online learning for the regular functioning of school activities. Grading assessments and examinations took place on a secure platform, so our transcripts were unaffected. The students adapted and responded to the challenges posed by the uncertain times. However, since January 2022 we have been back to offline school with minimal covid-related disturbances. Allowances are made for a hybrid or online mode when students or faculty are in quarantine. Student life in terms of exchange trips, CAS interface, in-person internships and some competitive examinations continue to have limited exposure.

GRADING

In Grades 9 and 10, IGCSE = A^* to U (with A^* the highest), and ICSE = % marks. In Grades 11 and 12 the IB awards Grades of 7 to 1 (with 7 being the highest).

RANKING AND CGPA CALCULATION

Students at DAIS are not ranked, however all students from Grade 9 - 12 receive an unweighted Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) based upon work completed in Grade 9 through to 12 according to a 4-point CPA conversion table listed on the high school transcript. Final IB Results are not included in the CGPA calculations.

UNIVERSITY APPLICATION LIMITS

At DAIS we believe that students and universities alike are better served when students make informed choices early in the application process. We therefore limit our Seniors to a maximum of 12 colleges worldwide. As a result, colleges and universities can know that an application from a DAIS student reflects genuine interest.
