5	<b>World Robotics Olympiad- 6<sup>th</sup> Rank in the world</b>	<p>Riyaan Bakhda- Class XI and his team aimed to provide a safer and cheaper alternative to replace the hazardous and toxic methods of packing food in plastic containers, Newspaper and aluminium foil. The project was a commercial Artificial-Intelligence enabled robotic system which fabricated food containers using banana leaves and hygienically packed food in them. The prototype machine was programmed to automatically cut, process, scan and sterilize raw leaves to make them usable for food packaging. The team secured <b>First place</b> in the senior Open Category and was chosen from over 50 competing teams to represent India at the international Championship in Thailand. Here too, the team won the <b>6<sup>th</sup> Rank</b> from 40 teams from over 35 countries at the International World Robot Olympiad (WRO)</p>
